First Congregational Church COVID Guidelines

These guidelines (Fig. 1) are based on current Kalamazoo County COVID Community Levels, as set by the CDC (Fig. 2). These levels are determined by inpatient bed occupancy, new hospital admissions, and the current level of new cases per 100,000 population over the past 7 days. As this is the best metric we have to measure current COVID rates in our community, this is what FCC is using to determine what safety measures need to be in place during worship. We put these in place to have an easy-to-follow guide that allows for quick, clear response to the rise and fall of COVID rates in our community. These are general guidelines and may be changed or amended as according to the most current science and as Church Council and Staff feel is necessary to protect the congregation's health.

Important Things to Note:

- Masks will always be required for singing, no matter the community transmission level.
- Vaccinations are strongly encouraged.
- Do not come to church if you are feeling ill or experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19.
- These guidelines apply to any activities occurring within the church building, both those hosted by the church and by external groups. They do not apply to outdoor activities happening on church grounds.
